Luppitt Neighbourhood Plan

Under the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 and the Localism Act 2011, Luppitt Parish Council have prepared a Neighbourhood Plan for the parish of Luppitt, with the help of the local community. The plan sets out a vision for the future of the parish and planning policies which will be used to determine planning applications in the area.

The Plan has been formally submitted to East Devon District Council as the Local Planning Authority. Comments are invited on the Plan under (Regulation 16) Submission Consultation.

The consultation runs from **22nd March 2022** to **midnight 6th May 2022**.
